- Capital of the French Riviera
- 5th major city in France
- 2nd tourist hub
- 2nd international airport in France
- 10 000 hotel rooms
- 300 days of sunshine



Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolitan Area

- 49 towns and villages between sea and mountains
- 1 400 km2
- 550 inhabitants
- 6 marinas
- 7 ski resorts





The green Metropolis of the Mediterranean

- 59 natural areas of ecological interest, 80% natural land, 10 km of coast-line, 45 lakes
- Mercantour National Park
- Pélagos marine sanctuary
- Territorial air-energy climate plan
- First French airport to obtain carbon neutrality
- Multi-modal and environment-friendly transport system
- 155km of cycle paths
- Shared bicycle and electric car rental



Our challenges

- Improve the spread of visitors
 Over the year: further promote off-season vacations
 Over a wider geographic area: attract more visitors to activities and vacations outside the city
- Growing demand for a more meaningful, value-based tourism Healthy living/eating, fresh air, outdoor activities
 Authenticity, local skills and products
 Original « off the beaten track » experiences
- Requirements of a more personal travel experience
 Increased need for specific and detailed information
 More active and less static form of travel (itineraries, road-trips)
- Post-covid recovery

Digital communication

- New multi-lingual mobile-first web platform to be launched in June 2021
 Affinity-based search engine, itinerary planning, zero-carbon stays
- Newsletters, travel blog articles and social network posts
- Marketplace for on-line booking of accommodation, activities, city-cards
- Interactive information terminals around the city

- 250 open data records concerning tourism, culture, heritage and transport
- Integration of the national shared tourism data base APIDAE
